



I am going to a live performance at the Playhouse.

I can find the entry to the Playhouse on Hunter Street, right across from the Civic light rail station.






When I go through the doors I can take the lift or the stairs to get to the Playhouse foyer.






The toilets are located on the first floor, at the top of the stairs and right near the lift. There are accessible toilets, female and male toilets and a baby change table available.





In the foyer I can collect my tickets, buy a drink and sit down and relax before the performance starts. The foyer might be busy when I arrive with many people waiting for the show.







Chimes will ring when the performance is about to start. I can take the stairs or the lift up to the next level to get to the theatre.

To get to my seat I may walk in front of other people. Other people may walk in front of me to get to their seat too.




On the stage there will be items set up for the show.

If I see something that makes me nervous I can cover my eyes, wear earphones or go out into the foyer to take a break.




During the show there will be some times when the actors interact with the audience.
