CREATING CHARACTERS AND STORIES

Students will break down the classic three-act story structure, and build dramatic tension through character and narrative, shaped by the elements of drama. Through writing tasks and small group research, students will develop a suite of scenarios and jump up to bring them to life through characterisation and movement. Using a watch-and-do method, students will investigate gaps in their narrative arc, and develop a key understanding of the role of the audience in presenting their work.

PERFORMANCE SKILLS

Give your students a boost towards their end-of year show, as students work on their foundational performance skills in voice projection, staging for a live audience, blocking, and more. INTRODUCTION TO DRAMA

Welcome to drama! Wipe your feet and take off your coat and jump into a circle. This dynamic workshop introduces the foundations of drama through practical activities such as improvisation, story telling, and more. Explore the elements of drama through games and exercises which build trust, foster creativity, and raise confidence. Students will develop their understanding of taking on roles, developing characters, and working within different dramatic forms. A great "all rounder" to introduce your students to concepts of drama in the Creative Arts syllabus.

FOUNDATIONS OF PLAYBUILDING

Get up and MAKE! in this active workshop which introduces students to playbuilding. Through movement and generated text, students will weave the elements of drama into creating an original piece of theatre, building ensemble skills along the way. Students will hone their skills in collaboration and group devising, as they explore their own dramatic interests in a supportive environment. At the conclusion of this workshop, students will have a short original play ready to present to other classes or at assembly.
